<b>Recipe for Dictatorship</b>	Use what you've read in <i>Animal Farm</i> to help you create a recipe for cooking up a dictatorship. Write detailed directions that a power-hungry individual could easily follow to create his or her own dictatorship. Your recipe should list ingredients needed, prep work involved, information about special tools or implements required, and directions to be followed.
<b>Standing up for Yourself for Dummies</b>	Write step-by-step guidelines to help individuals become more assertive, especially those in a situation similar to that of the "lower" animals in <i>Animal Farm</i> . Look for the instances where the animals could have done or said something that would have helped them maintain equality on the farm. Explain what they should have done or said, and show how it would have improved the situation. Provide clear guidance with plenty of examples to help your readers learn how to protect their rights successfully.
<b>Eavesdropping on the Pigs</b>	<i>Animal Farm</i> is told from a third-person limited point of view; readers learn about the events on the farm from the perspective of the "lower" animals. Imagine the conversations that the pigs have when the other animals are not around. Focusing on specific events, create a dialog to show the pigs' thoughts and feelings about what is happening in the story. Alternatively, retell part of the story from the perspective of the pigs.
