3. guise noun	1. A form or style of dress; costume. 2. External appearance; semblance.
4. indolent adjective	Averse to activity, effort, or movement; habitually lazy.
5. jovial adjective	Markedly good-humored especially as evidenced by jollity and conviviality; merry.
6. pall noun	Something that covers or conceals; especially, an overspreading element that produces an effect of gloom <a pall of thick black smoke>.
7. perennial adjective	Present at all seasons of the year.
8. placid adjective	Serenely free of interruption or disturbance.
9. ruddy adjective	Having a healthy reddish color.
10. sagacious adjective	Of keen and farsighted judgment; discerning <sagacious judge of character>.
